

SCC/PTO meeting 10/21/2021 minutes

Mr. Kelly - Discussion of Title 1, LAND Trust, TSS, and general budgets

- Washington had a \$20k cut in Title 1 funds this year - this is based on the number of students that apply for free lunch
- All Title 1 funds are used for teachers salaries
- Goal is to keep all FTE (full time employees) and have 2 full time Kindergarten teachers
- \$30k from the LAND trust fund, this pays for 1.5 TSS paraprofessionals (\$20k pays for 1 paraprofessional)
- This year they projected 236 students and there are 230 enrolled

Mr. Kelly - Emergency Safety Plan

- The plan is drafted and will be posted on the Washington Stars website
- Teachers have annual trainings
- There are color coded flip charts for different emergencies
- There are monthly fire drills, drills for earthquakes, secure lock downs
- The secondary location is the West High's field house
- On page 27, phone numbers of 6 adults at Washington are listed - certified in first aid and CPR

Mr. Kelly - Halloween Parade

- Parade will be outdoors for COVID safety
- Held at the end of the school day on Friday so parents can take their children home right after the parade
- Rules for costumes - no masks (except face masks), no weapons, no gory makeup

Ms. Gleason - Book Fair

- Book fair starting Monday, October 25th - Friday
- Student lead book fair
- Parents can set up eWallets for their students
- Online book fair will be two weeks, free shipping if you spend \$25 or more
- No families at the book fair because of COVID safety precautions
- School is hoping to have \$5 per student so each student can get a book. (magic number is \$1,400)
- Updates will be posted to Class Dojo so parents and students can prepare
