Elections

Updates from last year

- **Kindergarten play area shade (Katherine Kennedy)**; process has been slowed as the full district is being served, she contacted Paul Schulte requesting priority for Washington in the schedule and will accept our feedback on how to proceed.
- **Update on Hillside (Ashley Anderson)**
 - 325K allocation is delayed, it doesn't include the field. New member, Andrea Pastenbaugh has considered the wear and tear from dogs and requests an option for dogs to the south of the school while also requesting that the drainage problem be explored in relationship to hillside repairs.
 - Ashley will message Paul and invite him to the next meeting; she will also send a sample e-mail text for parents and families who may wish to request the same solutions for dogs and drainage on the field.
- This year's SCC plan (Aaron Garrett & John Kelly); SCC and PFFOW are separate organizations. SCC is responsible by state statute for deciding how to spend Trust Land money to address an academic need. This year we are spending funds on our counselor and regrettably missed a deadline for a matching funds application. John will send Ashley the district application correspondence so she can e-mail Rep. Steve Eliason about the implementation of this policy and send a sample message for those who may wish to contact the district.
- **Action Items!** Chair and Vice Chair will make agendas on issues families would like addressed. These include: field/hillside, updates to staffing, crosswalks & crossing guard concerns, BTS schedule and contracted instruction for fall, ELP Discovery Groups, technology grants.
