Trust LAND plan:

Review current plan (funding counselor)

Brainstorm for 2019-2020 plan: in the spring we will review if this is the best way to spend our money, or if we need to use the funds some other way. Will be dependent on staffing reports which come in February. Grant for ¼ counselor???
